Buckspeak

Well, it's come and gone – the peak, the pinnacle, the apogee of excitement in a chessplayer's year. I refer, of course, to the annual CSCA Membership Meeting, which makes the Colorado Open all worthwhile.

Tony Wilson will undoubtedly write his usual eloquent notes for publication in this or another issue, so I will just hit some high points. Various reports were given. Chris Hendrickson's, as always, was the most entertaining and instructive. The Tour winners were announced – see elsewhere in this issue for the list. Trophies and plaques were not available, so I will be giving those out at future tournaments – yet another good reason to show up.

Sadly, we are losing the services of two outstanding CSCA officers. Debra Johnson and Ron MacRall did not run for re-election. Tony Wilson, Peter Daw, Todd Bardwick, and I remain in our offices. New faces are Carl Van Laethem moving to Vice-President, Pat Bruno taking on the Treasurer's job, and Joyce Baldwin as a new Member at Large. Joyce came strongly recommended to take over the position of Scholastics Co-ordinator as well. Garth Courtois is our new USCF Delegate. We have gained a fourth USCF voting member, and these worthies were chosen: George Spentzos, Vance Aandahl, Michael Fuchs, and Carl Van Laethem.

This year's USCF Delegates meeting was held August 12 - 13 in Concord, California, the site of the US Open. Our David Neal - Glikzman shone in that tournament; he tied for second place, beating Walter Browne! Also playing were Anthea Carson of Colorado Springs (who won the top Class D prize) and former Coloradans Jim Burden and Mark Pifer.

The meeting itself was a tense one. There has been much political restlessness in USCF this year. The hottest issue was the USCF's support of the Campomanes - Kasparov junta in the Moscow FIDE conference. (For details see the January 23 issue of *Inside Chess*.) I thought this action by the USCF Policy Board was a disgrace: an unprincipled capitulation to big money and special interests. Equally pathetic (in my opinion) is the article in the August *Chess Life* that whitewashes the whole business, laying down the official party line with not a hint of anything disagreeable. Evidently many other Delegates agreed with me, as the meeting got distinctly livelier as this topic came up. Delegates even went so far as to try to refuse to ratify this decision of the Policy Board, based on irregularities in the way the vote was conducted. Some skillful parliamentary water-muddying by PB member Bill Snead succeeded in confusing the issue, and by the time things got straightened out the "reasonable" folks prevailed and the ratification vote passed. Later a series of motions led by Harold Winston let the Delegates state our feelings on the issue. But of course the matter was a done deal and nothing could be changed at that point.

The tension showed throughout the meeting. An early statement by President Barry criticized "happy talk," cheerful Panglossian optimism that everything would be all right if we stay polite. Nervous jokes prevailed: little junior-high barbs about Steve Doyle being fat, or Harold Winston being short. Some PB members hardly spoke a word the whole time. Even Jerry Hanken (no longer on the Board),

The Idea: On June 10-11, 33 players gathered at the Falcon Police Station in Colorado Springs to play in the INSANITY II. This unique tournament was the idea of Ron Smits, Colorado Springs newest tournament director. The format was simple, 18 rounds of G/30 and whoever had the most points at the end was the winner. Four years ago the first Insanity tournament was held, but it received very little recognition and even a smaller turnout. However, this year things were different. The 1995 Insanity II was a complete success due to the directing of Ron Smits and his assistant Red Turner.

The Players: Who would show their face at a tournament whose very name separated "real" chessplayers from the rest of society? A brave group of 33 players traveled from far and near to participate in this challenge to stay awake. Three masters and five experts topped the field of chess-maniacs. Notably, David Glikzman, the current state champion, and Dr. Ponomarev, a past state champion, braved the midnight hour to duke it out for the right to be dubbed "most insane".


The Competition: The games began at exactly 12:15 PM. and immediately one could sense the danger. Round one ended with Dr. Ponomarev (2279) being mated in a time scramble by Victor Smith (1700). The smaller fish in the pond were hungry for wins and many upsets were afoot. After six rounds a pizza party was thrown for the players. Over twenty pizzas were devoured on their dinner break. Hungriest chessplayer? John Hall won hands down with over six slices to his credit. John Hall added a unique flavor to the tournament. Although Mr. Hall only worked on his books, he paid his dues by staying up with the rest of us. I blew a gut trying to squeeze down my fifth slice. Let us not forget that the vegetarians were supplied with meatless pizzas for their dining pleasure, your welcome Doud! After the break it was back to the chess and some unfortunate post-meal comatose. This rather rare condition is an involuntary coma or sleep induced by a mixture of chess and overeating. The first victim was 13th round opponent Red Turner. During our game he fell asleep only to awake with a start as I punched his clock. Soon many others were inflicted by this condition and the room began to look more like the sleep disorder ward in a hospital than a serious chess tournament. Enough talk, bring on the games!

The Games: Here are some of the over 200 games played at the Insanity II. Needless to say not many of the games were turned in and half of the ones that were had mistakes, omissions, and numerous other problems caused by fatigue.

everybody's favorite scapegoat, was strangely restrained. And the "Friends of the USCF" weren't even there!

Ah, well, to something definite. The election results were announced: Fan Adams was elected to the PB by a sizable majority (including my vote), and I was elected Regional Vice-President of USCF Region IX (Colorado, Utah, Wyoming, Kansas). This Region is huge in area but small in numbers of Voting Members. Only 12 people in these 4 states were eligible to vote in the elections. I got 5 votes, my opponent (Norm Jenson of Utah) got 4, and there was one write-in for Ralph Bowman of Kansas! Neither of the current RVPs (both from Utah) voted. This sweeping mandate means basically whatever I want to make it mean. Hopefully I can at least improve communication within the Region. Watch this column for developments. The last three Colorado RVPs have all dropped out of chess, a trend I intend to "buck." (pun!) Some campaigning started for next summer's PB elections. I am tentatively supporting Don Schultz of Florida for USCF President.

Some things came out of the meeting that may affect the tournament player. There was a motion to eliminate rating floors. I watched my lifetime 2100 rating trembling in the balance as the matter was referred to the Ratings Committee. PB member Frank Camaratta proposed an alternative plan that showed me how little he understood the current system. This also was referred. Motions were made to decriminalize pre-arranged draws, since rules against them are so hard to enforce anyway. One suggestion was to allow non-rated, non-played draws, while other folks thought such games should still be rated. A straw poll indicated support for this relaxation of the rules (I voted no.) and this also was referred to an appropriate committee and the Policy Board. The Rules Committee came up with a sheet of rules to use with a new digital / time delay clock that will soon be appearing, a version of the Bobby Fischer clock that adds a certain amount of time for each move played. These are already in use in some invitational tournaments, but it will probably be quite a while till they take over in Colorado.

I am looking forward to a good year for Colorado chess. We are working constructively at getting problems solved, and there is some good energy getting pumped into scholastics. Let's all play in lots of tournaments and help out wherever we can — and may all your ratings increase!

Prison Chess Report

The following is a transcript of Chris Hendrickson's report at the annual CSCA membership meeting. - Ed.

One would have thought that when they appointed me to the board of the USCF National Prison Chess Committee that I could accomplish a lot more than in past years. But such has not been the case. The Corrections Department (COD) is

stretched beyond the limit of its capacity and all kinds of programs are getting the axe.

The corrections officer most in favor of chess programs, Bill Coyle, lost his job. This was because the COD has concluded that libraries, not chess libraries, regular libraries, are an expensive extravagance. So they're letting all the librarians go and reducing the positions of running the libraries to Library Tech positions. I'm a library tech, and trust me, they don't make any money at all, especially compared to librarians. It goes on and on.

Now when I'm expecting to be able to do more this year, everything I tried to do fell through. The good news is the Federal Correctional Institute (FCI), in Englewood, has finally unbanned me after five years. They're a fairly suspicious bunch, and had become convinced that I was part of some sinister conspiracy. But after five years they called me up a said, "Where've you been?". I guess they figured I wasn't into much except chess. They had plenty of time to check me.

I'll try to see if I can't bring someone down there for a simul. Steve Diekhoff has unwisely volunteered. Randy Canney also said he might come but he's a lawyer, so he might not be allowed. In the past, I've had a good time bringing Todd Bardwick to Centennial.

So all I've done is send out a blizzard of correspondence as usual and picked up a few sets at garage sales to use in future prison demos.

Remember, this country locks up more people than any other. One day, they may get you. It may not be because of what you did. Every one makes mistakes. So please visit your chessplayer comrades who wind up locked up. Play them a game if they allow it. Encourage them to form a chess club inside if they don't.

The CSCA Prison Chess Committee is here to help any way it can.
